


About *Into a Wider World*

Into a Wider World covers Karl's time at Valparaiso University, which also happens to be the key years of the civil rights movement, the early years of the Native Americans rights movement, and some of the most active years of the Lutheran Human Relations Association of America. He shares stories from his work in these endeavors and of being a pastor as well as memories that illustrate the profound value of lifelong friendships.

If you are looking for insightful stories to spark deep and meaningful conversations with your students, congregation or community group, pick up a copy.
